### **News & Information**

**Leaf Pick-Up:** Leaf pick-up will begin when the majority of the leaves start to fall, usually the end of October, and continue to the end of November or first snow fall. Place leaves at the curb, not in the street. Piles should only consist of leaves; no branches, twigs and other yard waste as it could cause damage to our leaf vac and delay the schedule of pickup. Contact the Department of Public Works at 269.624.6406 with any questions or concerns.

**Leaf Bags:** The Village no longer sells leaf bags. You can find biodegradable bags locally at Adams Hardware, Walmart, or online at Amazon.com.

Time Change: Don't forget to turn your clocks back one hour on Sunday, November 06, 2022!

**Avoid Freezing Pipes:** As the temperature starts to drop, the risk of freezing pipes increases, especially in older homes with uninsulated pipes. Here are a few ways to keep your pipes from freezing:

• *Keep garage doors closed:* especially if there are water supply lines in the garage

• *Open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors:* this allows warmer air to circulate around the plumbing

• *Keep the thermostat to the same temperature:* during the day and night, this will also save a few bucks on your heating bill

• Add insulation to attics, basements, and crawl spaces: doing so can maintain higher temperatures in those areas

• Let cold water drip from ONE faucet: Running water, even at a trickle, helps prevent water from freezing. You will need to contact the Village Clerk's Office to be placed on a drip list.
