Village of Lawton Downtown Social District

The Lawton Village Council recently approved a Social District in Downtown Lawton, and it is currently at the State level pending approval. Memorial Day weekend is the target date for the Social District to open.

The Social District allows for people to consume alcohol in designated "common areas", including along sidewalks, in Cannon Park, and in a few other designated downtown areas. Any alcohol consumed must be purchased from an approved downtown business – it can not be brought into the commons area or purchased from unapproved establishments.

Not only does the Social District allow patrons to safely consume alcohol, but it also allows them to support the downtown community during times of limited indoor dining. As warm weather descends on Michigan, Lawton is one of 50 communities around the State creating "social districts" under a state initiative that advocates say will spur social and economic involvement in downtown economies. If the bar or restaurant is crowded and you feel like getting outside for some fresh air, you can do that. If you're done with your meal and you want stroll downtown and take your drink with you, that's fine too. Our Social District will operate year-round, seven days a week, and be open for operation Sunday through Thursday from 11am to 10pm and Eriday and Satur

operation Sunday through Thursday from 11am to 10pm, and Friday and Saturday from 11am to 11pm. p.m. Stay tuned for more updates to follow as we roll out this new and exciting addition to Downtown Lawton!
