### **Parking On Sidewalks**

With winter upon us, it is the goal and responsibility of the Village of Lawton's Department of Public Works (DPW) to maintain our streets to ensure the safety of our residents and visitors. During the winter months, that responsibility includes the removal of accumulated snow on the roads. Remember, per ordinance 70.03 (6), no vehicle or trailer shall be parked on or across any sidewalk except while attended for the purpose of loading or unloading. This is especially important in the winter months to facilitate plowing the roads.

Please do your part to keep our sidewalks clear of vehicles so they can be properly maintained. If you have questions regarding your current parking situation, please contact the Lawton Police Department for guidance.
